
Post-workshop Survey Results

Survey results indicate that workshops are an effective way to disseminate knowledge about the Genome Browser. Both novice (top, 6 pages) and experienced (bottom, 6 pages) users indicate that they learn new things, the workshop was relevant for their work and that they would recommend workshops to colleagues. They also generally prefer a live workshop to video content. Data are from a group of 30 attendees who attended at Radboud Medical Center in Nijmegen, The Netherlands in March, 2015. They were chosen because they had a good balance of novice and regular users. They are representative of aggregate data from numerous workshops. Direct export from SurveyMonkey using filters.


